Due to state restrictions on large gatherings, we will not have the Harvest Dinner in November.

In order to keep everyone safe, volunteers will sit 1 or 2 at a table in the lower auditorium to assemble baskets. All supplies will be provided. If you want to volunteer, but don't feel safe doing so at church, you can pick up the supplies, assemble the basket at your home, and then deliver it. Every volunteer will deliver the baskets they make. Deliveries will be grouped according to proximity of residents.

If you are serving somewhere on Sunday morning (nursery, worship, sound, etc.), please stop by the check-in station before heading to your scheduled post. We want to be as accurate as possible with our attendance.
